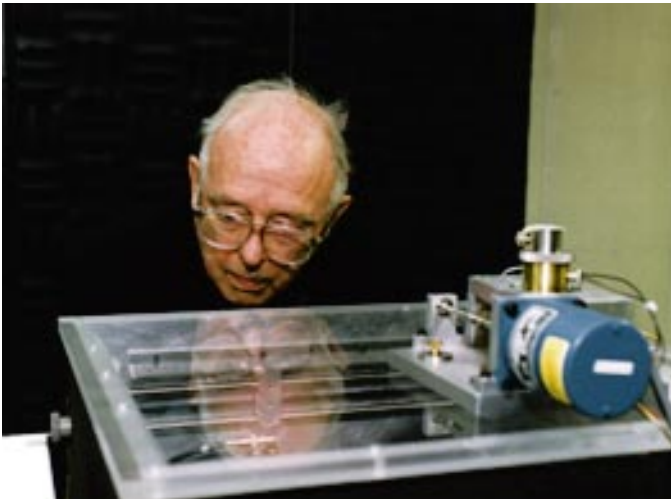

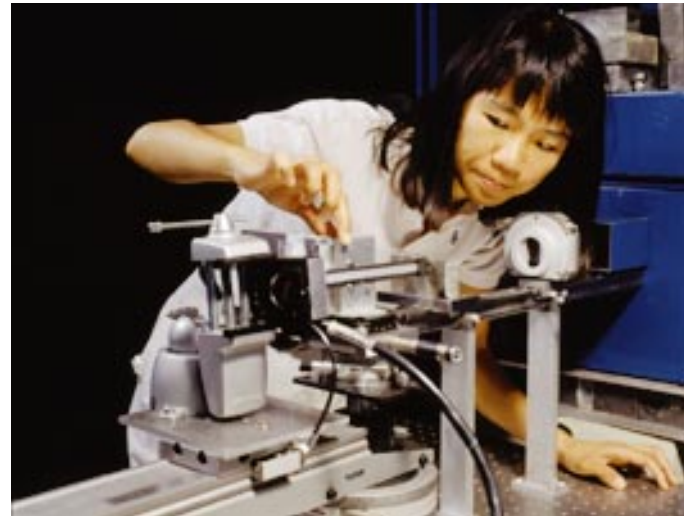
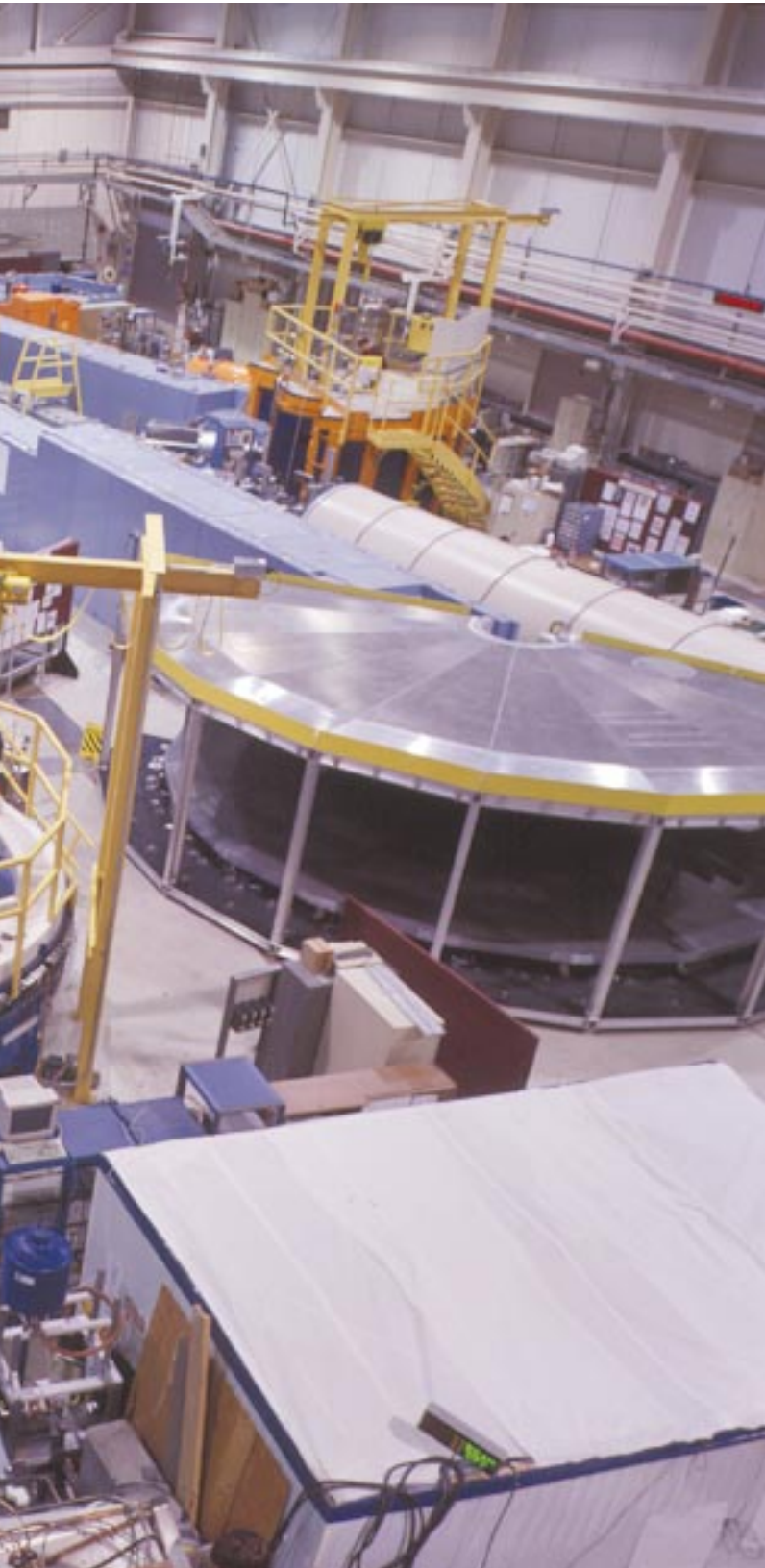

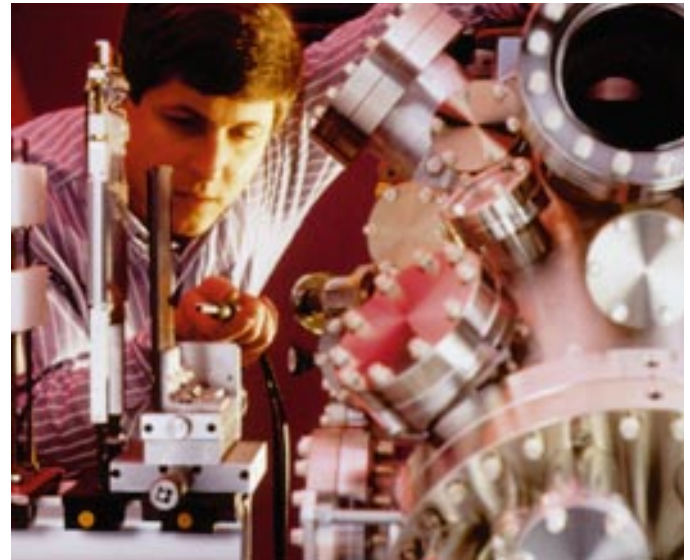

Below: Guide hall at the NCNR, as of early 1999.

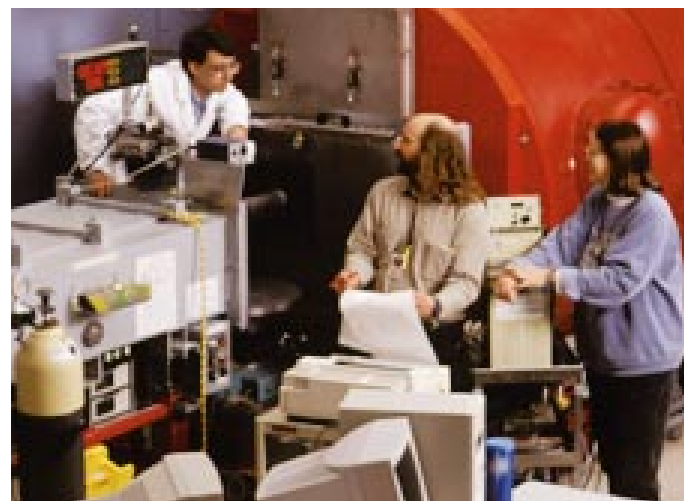
